

WORLD DIABETES DAY CELEBRATION

World Diabetes Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm at Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Institute of Medical Sciences & Hospital, located on Thuraiyur Road, Perambalur. The hospital organized a series of events to raise awareness about diabetes and provide valuable medical support to the community.
