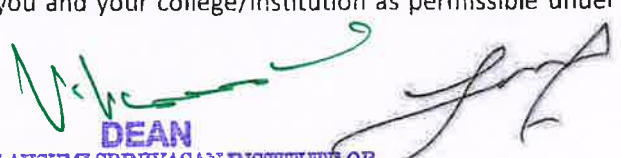

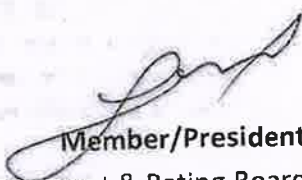

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to convey that all medical colleges/Institutes with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) for MBBS admission must upload details/data on the NMC portal for the Annual Declaration as per the NMC Act 2019 requirements and other relevant regulations. Accordingly, Public notices have been issued, and colleges/Institutions were directed to submit the details on the portal.

2. The experts assessed the details submitted by your college, and accordingly, your college was issued a show cause notice containing the details of deficiencies observed by the experts while evaluating the annual declaration form, video of examination, and SAF-C provided by your college along with the AEBAS report.

3. Vide the above show cause notice issued to your college, it was directed to furnish the point-wise reply within three days (3 days) of issuance of show cause as to why the seats allocated to your institution for MBBS not be reduced in A-Y 2024-25, or should a monetary penalty as per the regulations not be imposed as your college has not fulfilled the provisions laid down under NMC Act 2019 and other relevant guidelines, regulation notified by NMC.

Further, vide the above show cause notice issued, your medical



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college/institute was given an additional opportunity to present the explanation on the observations, if any, through the virtual hearing before the Undergraduate Medical Education Board.

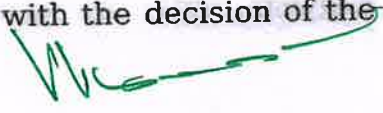
4. In the above virtual hearing conducted on **18.06.2024**, in which your college was represented by **the Dean of the college**. In this hearing, the competent authority reviewed the observations by the assessor, and have found the breaches to be substantial, and the clarification provided by your college was found to be unsatisfactory. While this Board recognize that your college has accepted its justifications have not addressed concerns raised and has assured of addressing the same at the earliest. Not on-boarded on AEBAS portal directly prevents the UGMEB to assess the available number of Faculties to teach students.

5. For effective and convenient digital solution to recording the attendance of faculties, Senior Residents and Tutors of Medical Colleges, Biometric Attendance System has been introduced. Here, it is pertinent to reiterate that the medical colleges/institutes were first intimated for implementation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) vide NMC letter dated 01st August, 2022 through Public Notice uploaded on the website of the Commission. Further, implementation of AEBAS and its module were also made available to all Medical Colleges/Institutes vide various circulars/public notices available on the NMC website and show cause notices stating to initiate action to fulfill the provisions laid in various regulations and guidelines by NMC.

6. The competent authority is of the view that in all respect your college becomes the fit case for reduction of seats due to non-adherence of guidelines, regulations notified and issued by NMC from time to time. Since the portal for submission of the Annual Declaration Form has been introduced for first time, taking a lenient view, the Board decided to grant renewal of **150 seats** for undergraduate (MBBS) for the year 2024-25, subject to deposit of a fine of **Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen lacs only)** as a first measure; however, a reassessment will be done after two months. If deficiencies exist with your college, this organization initiates the stringent action as mandated under MSMER-2023 Chapter-III clause-8 and any other relevant act and rules.

7. As per, it is directed to remit the penalty amount within Seven days (7 days) into "NMC Own Resources, Canara Bank Account No. **90682160000025**, IFSC code **CNRB0019109** and forward confirmation of payment along with transaction details to **ug.scn@nmc.org.in**.

8. If you are not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the



Board, you are free to prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.

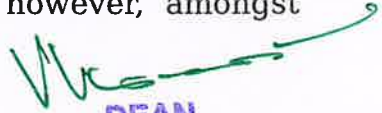
Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Notice dated **19.05.2025** was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

- i. Eleven (11) out of Twenty (20) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
- ii. Three (03) Departments out of Twenty (20) Department are deficient in faculty/SR as per self declaration.
- iii. Blood Bank license expiring on 20/03/2026.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst


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other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

- i. Some departments are still deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data, however your explanation has been accepted therefore, the college may adhere to the deficiencies found in the AEBAS.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report (ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 150 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.

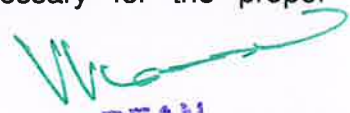

Dear Sir/Madam,

WHEREAS, Online Application/Scheme No. NMC/UGI/2026-2027/0025 was submitted to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB), National Medical Commission (NMC), seeking permission for an increase in intake of 100 (One Hundred) MBBS seats at **Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Institute of Medical Sciences and Hospital, Perambalur, Tamil Nadu**, from the Academic Year (A.Y.) 2026-27.

2. WHEREAS, Section 28(2) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 mandates that every applicant shall submit a scheme to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board in such form and containing such particulars as may be prescribed under the relevant regulations. Further, the proviso to Regulation 9 of the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023 provides that an incomplete application, including one not accompanied by the mandatory documents prescribed under the Regulations, is liable to be rejected;

3. WHEREAS, Section 29 of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 read with Regulation 11 of the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023, requires the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, while considering a scheme under Section 28, to assess, inter alia, the adequacy of financial resources, availability of academic faculty, hospital facilities, infrastructure, and such other prescribed criteria necessary for the proper functioning of the proposed medical college;


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4. **WHEREAS**, the Public Notice dated **22.12.2025** inviting applications for the Academic Year 2026-27 specifically stipulates that:

"The regulatory framework does not contemplate a 'work-in-progress' status at the time of application; rather, it obligates readiness and demonstrable compliance ab initio. Therefore, any plea of being in the process of completing infrastructure or requesting additional time defeats the very objective of the scheme under the Act and Regulations and is wholly impermissible."

5. **WHEREAS**, upon scrutiny of the application under Section 29 of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, read with Regulations 11 and 12 of the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023, and the Public Notice dated 22.12.2025, the following deficiencies were observed and communicated to the applicant through **Show Cause Notice dated 08.05.2026**:

6. **WHEREAS**, the applicant institution was afforded an opportunity under Section 28(3) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, read with Regulation 13 of the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023, vide **Show Cause Notice dated 08.05.2026**, to rectify the aforesaid deficiencies and submit a compliance report within **seven (07) working days**,

7. **WHEREAS**, the applicant institution submitted its compliance report on **11.05.2026**, along with the documents furnished in support of its response to the Show Cause Notice. The compliance submitted by the applicant was duly examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB);

8. **WHEREAS**, Section 28(7) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 empowers the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) to conduct the evaluation and assessment/inspection of any medical institution at any time, either directly or through experts having integrity and experience in the medical profession, **without any prior notice**. Accordingly, MARB conducted an inspection of the institution through duly appointed assessors, and the assessment report submitted by the assessors was examined by the Expert Committee constituted by MARB before making its recommendations.

9. **WHEREAS**, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB), National Medical Commission (NMC), after examining the application, the assessment report, the recommendations of the Expert Committee, the compliance submitted by the applicant institution, and all other relevant records in accordance with the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, the Undergraduate Medical Education Standards Regulations (UGMSR), 2023, the Establishment of Medical Institutions, Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023, and the Public Notice inviting applications for the Academic Year 2026-27, **has decided to approve the**


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scheme and grant a Letter of Permission (LoP) under Section 28(3) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 for an partial increase in intake of 50 (Fifty) MBBS seats (from 150 to 200) at Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Institute of Medical Sciences and Hospital, Perambalur, Tamil Nadu from the Academic Year 2026–27, subject to the provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, the regulations framed thereunder, and the terms and conditions specified herein.

11. Terms and Conditions

I. The applicant and the institution shall be solely responsible for ensuring continued compliance with the provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, the regulations framed thereunder, and all directions, guidelines, advisories, and public notices issued by the National Medical Commission (NMC) from time to time. The institution shall maintain, throughout the academic year, the prescribed standards relating to physical infrastructure, hospital infrastructure, human resources, teaching faculty, clinical material, equipment, and all other statutory requirements.

II. If, at any stage, it is found that this Letter of Permission has been obtained on the basis of any false declaration, misrepresentation, suppression of material facts, or submission of fabricated or forged documents, or if such misconduct comes to the notice of the National Medical Commission during a physical or virtual assessment, surprise inspection, or otherwise, MARB shall be at liberty to withdraw, cancel, or revoke this Letter of Permission. In addition, the institution shall be liable for such action as may be permissible under the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, including denial or withdrawal of recognition of the medical qualification and any other action deemed appropriate under law.

III. The medical college and its attached teaching hospital shall comply with all applicable statutory requirements, including those relating to **building safety, occupancy, fire safety, pollution control, environmental protection, biomedical waste management, radiation safety**, and all other approvals, licenses, and clearances required under the applicable laws.

IV. The medical college shall develop and maintain an official website containing updated information regarding the institution, including:

- a. courses offered and sanctioned intake;
- b. teaching faculty and their qualifications and experience;
- c. student admissions;
- d. affiliating university;
- e. hospital services and facilities;
- f. departmental infrastructure and equipment;
- g. OPD and IPD statistics; and
- h. Birth and death records maintained under the applicable laws.

V. The institution shall comply with the following additional conditions:

- a. MARB reserves the right to withdraw, cancel, or revoke this Letter of

Permission if it is found that the permission has been obtained by fraud, misrepresentation, suppression of material facts, or submission of false or fabricated documents.

b. MARB reserves the right to conduct physical and/or virtual assessments, including surprise inspections, at any stage and to take appropriate action based on the findings thereof.

c. The institution shall strictly comply with all the conditions stipulated in this Letter of Permission. MARB shall have the right to call for any information or conduct such an enquiry as may be necessary to verify compliance with these conditions in both letter and spirit.

d. MARB may take appropriate regulatory action against the institution for failure to maintain the standards prescribed by the Undergraduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) or the Postgraduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB), as the case may be, including issuance of warning, imposition of monetary penalty, reduction of intake capacity, stoppage of admissions, or recommendation to the Commission for withdrawal of recognition, in accordance with the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, and the regulations framed thereunder.

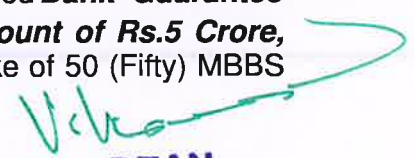
e. The institution shall furnish all admission-related information within the timelines prescribed by the National Medical Commission from time to time. Failure to submit such information within the stipulated period shall be treated as non-compliance with the statutory requirements governing admissions and may invite appropriate action under the National Medical Commission Act, 2019.

f. The medical college shall install, maintain, and ensure the continuous functioning of the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS), Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) surveillance system, Hospital Management Information System (HMIS), and such other information technology systems as may be prescribed by the National Medical Commission from time to time. The data generated by these systems shall be made available to the National Medical Commission whenever required.

Failure to do so may result in the refusal of renewal of permission or initiation of appropriate regulatory action, including withdrawal or revocation of this Letter of Permission, in accordance with the provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019.

VI. This Letter of Permission shall not be construed as a waiver of any statutory requirement or obligation under any applicable law. The institution shall obtain and maintain all approvals, licenses, certificates, and permissions required under the applicable Central, State, and local laws throughout its operation.
